- Perform administrative tasks, including budget formulation, player reporting, etc
- Represent Mooredale Soccer Club in a professional manner
- Adherence to coaching standards as set by the Technical Director, including reports on team activities, season long-plan
- Shall demonstrate the ability to set and maintain standards for players (ie. Respect, self-discipline, fair play, behavior, etc)
