### OVERVIEW

Due to our continued growth at Toronto Mooredale SC we are currently seeking applications for Coaches to be a part of our Technical Staff. The role would primarily be focused on the U8 through to our U12 Developmental Squads. This staff member would be working with our Technical Director and other Technical Staff to create a positive learning environment as we focus on the development of players in the U8-U12 ages here. Opportunities to work as a team trainer for the u13+ age groups are available to our Technical Staff only.

### GOALS

- Instruction in advanced soccer skills
- Create a global player at the youngest ages while being able to prepare them for positional play and individual roles on a team from the Club Development Plan
- Competition at a high level of play
- Building and maintaining a club identity while fostering individual excellence
- Encouraging commitment and self-discipline
- Encourage players to develop a 'love of the game', creativity, and fun.

### ACTIVITIES

- Weekly practices and game for players, working with the pool for the u8/u9 age groups, the u10/11, or the u12 age groups in the Academy Program.
- Festival Play – travelling to festivals
- Coaching matches
- Training Camp – attend the mini-training camp
- Upgrading qualifications through coaching certification clinics through the OSA, NSCAA, USSF
